based on Nakai Tablature for Native American Flute

The chart displays musical notation and fingering diagrams for the following notes:

- Root:** C4 (one hole), C5 (two holes), C6 (three holes), C7 (four holes), C8 (five holes), C9 (six holes), C10 (seven holes).
- Minor Third:** D4 (one hole), D5 (two holes), D6 (three holes), D7 (four holes), D8 (five holes), D9 (six holes), D10 (seven holes).
- Fourth:** E4 (one hole), E5 (two holes), E6 (three holes), E7 (four holes), E8 (five holes), E9 (six holes), E10 (seven holes).
- Fifth:** F4 (one hole), F5 (two holes), F6 (three holes), F7 (four holes), F8 (five holes), F9 (six holes), F10 (seven holes).
- Seventh:** G4 (one hole), G5 (two holes), G6 (three holes), G7 (four holes), G8 (five holes), G9 (six holes), G10 (seven holes).
- Octave:** A4 (one hole), A5 (two holes), A6 (three holes), A7 (four holes), A8 (five holes), A9 (six holes), A10 (seven holes).
- Minor Tenth:** B4 (one hole), B5 (two holes), B6 (three holes), B7 (four holes), B8 (five holes), B9 (six holes), B10 (seven holes).

Notes:

- Fingerings for Butch Hall Dm, Em, F#m, Gm drone, and Am flutes made prior to 2005.
- Fingerings for notes above the octave note may vary among individual flutes.
- Notes above the Minor Tenth may not resonate on a particular flute.
