

# Moonlight Creek Six-Hole NAF Fingerings

based on Nakai Tablature for Native American Flute

- Minor Tenth:** D6. Fingering: 1-2-3-4-5-6 (all holes covered).

- Fingerings for Moonlight Creek (Michael Gulino) flutes.
- Fingerings for notes above the octave note may vary among individual flutes.
- Notes above the Minor Tenth may not resonate on a particular flute.
