

Spirit of the Woods Six-Hole NAF Fingerings

based on Nakai Tablature for Native American Flute

developed by Clint Goss

- Root:** C5 (one hole covered)

- Minor Tenth:** D6 (two holes covered)

- Notes above the Minor Tenth may not resonate on a particular flute.
